In view of the continuous threat to the Civil Aviation Sector received from central security agencies, it is necessary to enhance the existing security measures being taken at all the Civil Aviation installations like airports, airstrips, airfields, air force stations, helipads flying schools, aviation training institutes

etc. so that no untoward incident takes place during Independence Day celebrations (August 15, 2019). Utmost precautions need to be taken by all the stake holders which may inter-alia include the following measures:

1. Strict on ground monitoring of regulatory guidelines for operations of non- conventional aerial platform like Microlite aircrafts, Aero models, Para gliders, Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS), Drones, power hang gliders and hot air balloons.
2. Strengthening of anti-terrorism/ anti-sabotage measures and placement of QRTs at all the airports. QRT and perimeter patrolling to be strengthened.
3. Intensive checking of vehicles/ persons at the approach (NAKA) to airport terminals/ installations.
4. Compulsory Secondary Ladder Point Checking (SLPC) of all the flights at all the airports.
5. Enhanced surveillance in and around the aviation installations.
6. Monitoring of flights / Helicopters/ UAV/ UAS/ Drone/ Gliders/ Hot Air Balloon from airports/ helipads/ airfield around Delhi NCR.
7. Enhanced security measures at cargo terminals. Manning of all cargo gates and vehicle entry gates will be strengthened with strong armed support by ASG/APSU. Local police will provide additional support round the clock.
8. Strict access control to regulate entry into terminal building, airside, all operational area and other aviation facilities.
9. Enhanced screening of passengers, including 100% full pat down search at Pre- embarkation security check point.
10. Enhanced random check at the entry of terminal building including utilization of BDDS Dog Squad at the entry point.
11. Landside security to be strengthened.
12. No vehicle to remain parked in front of the terminal building.
13. Enhanced security in parking areas of IGI airport.
14. Staff and visitors including enhanced random screening at the main gate to the terminal building.
15. Addition vigil together with the existing security measures of the catering being uplifted from the caterers. Inspection by the CSO of concerned airline from the presetting stage to vehicle check and entry into airside. ASG/APSU to ensure thorough check of the vehicle through under view mirror, cabin search etc. and checking of the driver and attendant and their ID matching of signatures.
16. Strict monitoring of non-scheduled flight operations including airambulance.

17. Thorough search and anti-sabotage check of the aircraft by the concerned airline and its guarding to ensure no unauthorized access to the aircraft. Also to ensure that no unauthorized person gains access to aero bridge.
18. Enhanced screening and protection of hold baggage.
19. All Airport Directors/ C.O.O shall convene special APSC meeting and advise all concerned agencies to take precautionary measures to preclude possibility of any act of unlawful interference.
20. **ENTRY OF VISITORS TO THE AIRPORTS AND SALE OF VISITORS ENTRY TICKETS SHALL BE BANNED W.E.F. 10 AUG, 2019 TO 20 AUG, 2019.** However, the alert being relaxed for TAEPs for operational purposes to Govt. functionaries. *to be issued by RD BCAS only.*
21. RD's of BCAS will ensure compliance.
